Carbon Capture, Utilisation & Storage in the energy transition: vital but limited

The ETC's latest report describes how carbon capture, utilisation and storage (CCUS) must play a vital but limited role in global decarbonization and emissions removals if the world is to meet its 1.5°C objectives. The report confirms that a profound transformation of the energy system is necessary to deliver a net-zero emission economy by mid-century. By 2050, clean electricity could provide 60-70% of the world's final energy demand, with a major role for low-carbon hydrogen, and a modest role for sustainable bioresources. As a low-carbon, not zero-carbon technology, CCUS has a complimentary role to play in decarbonisation but it must not lead to a continuation of fossil fuel consumption at today's levels.
